Live Viewing & Later Viewing

Things to know:

We stream 2 live services.

- 1. The 9:30 am service, AKA "9-3-0" or "Contemporary";
- 2. The 11:00 am service, AKA "Sanctuary" or "Traditional".

These services are streamed to our website (forthegoodofthecity.org), and to our Facebook page (@topekafirstumc).

If you have a smartphone/tablet and wish to view the services, first you need to go to your smartphone/tablet store and download the "Topeka First United Methodist" app.

If you choose to watch the sermon later, we offer 2 versions to watch.

- 1. The "Archive" version, which only contains:
 - a. Scripture reading
 - b. Sermon
 - c. Benediction
- 2. The full version for both the "Traditional" service and the "Contemporary" service.

Watch Live

Note: The following only works when we are streaming live.

On your PC: Open a browser and go to our website "forthegoodofthecity.org". Then click on the tab "Sermons", followed by clicking on "Live Stream". We would appreciate your completing the "Register Your Attendance" section, then click on the "Play" button in the center of the window. To view in full screen mode, click on the two opposing arrows in the lower right of the screen. To exit full screen, press the "Esc" key on your keyboard.

On your Smart Device: Open the "Topeka First United Methodist" app. At the top of the display you can click on the "Live" window to view our live stream at 9:30 am or 11:00 am.

On Facebook: Open Facebook on your smart device app or on your PC. Search for "Topeka First United Methodist". Once you are there, look for a window that has "Live" in the lower right corner. Click on that window to watch our service.

On your TV: You must have one of the following devices connected to your TV: *Roku*, *Apple TV*, or a *Chromecast*. Go to the app store for your device and download the app <u>Sunday Streams</u>. It will have the image of a highway running through it in the form of an "S". You can now click on the app to view the live stream and the last 2 weeks of archived sermons. The first time you click on the app, it will ask you to login. The login is **forthegoodofthecity**.

Watch Later last Sunday's Full version

On your PC: Open a browser and go to our website "forthegoodofthecity.org". Then click on the tab "Sermons", followed by clicking on "Sunday's Worship".

- 1. There are 2 windows side-by-side.
 - a. The left window contains the full version of last Sunday's sermon from the Contemporary (9:30) service.
 - b. The right window contains the full version of last Sunday's sermon from the Traditional (11:00) service.

<u>These full versions are only available for one week.</u> However, later we will explain how to find the full version of past sermons on YouTube.

Watch Later archived version

On your PC: Open a browser and go to our website "forthegoodofthecity.org". Then click on the tab "Sermons", followed by clicking on "Archive".

You are presented window panes for the various "Sermon Series". The current one that is displayed, is for the current sermon series. There is a symbol in the center right and center left of that window which will allow you to scroll through the various sermon series

Once you arrive at the sermon series you wish to view, click on the center of that window. At the right of the window pane, click on "Go to Page.....". You can now scroll down through the descriptions of each sermon. These are the <u>archived</u> version of the sermons. We sometimes select the Contemporary service and other times it will be from the Traditional service. As you can see, it contains all the sermons we have streamed.

On your Smart Device: Open the "Topeka First United Methodist" app. By scrolling up and down on your device, find the service you wish to view. Press the window of the sermon and watch the <u>archived</u> version of the sermon. We sometimes select the Contemporary service and other times it will be from the Traditional service. As you can see, it contains all the sermons we have streamed.

On your TV: You must have one of the following devices connected to your TV: *Roku*, *Apple TV*, or a *Chromecast*. Go to the app store for your device and download the app <u>Sunday Streams</u>. YouTube version always available

You can use any device that supports YouTube: (Smart Phone/tablet, PC, Smart TV)

If you prefer to watch the **FULL** version of a saved sermon, you can always find them on YouTube. **Once you are at the YouTube web site,** to search and only display our sermons, use the following search criteria: (Note: your punctuation must be exact)

intitle:"topeka first united methodist", archive

The last parameter after the comma can be "archive", "contemporary" or "traditional" depending on which service you prefer to watch. That search shows you all the services for our church.

If you know what book of the bible was used in the scripture reading, you could narrow your search. For example: locating a sermon from our church, that was a traditional service, and the scripture was from Psalm. Be careful and do not limit your search too much, otherwise you may not find the service.

intext: "Psalm" intitle: "topeka first united methodist", traditional

Audio only

On your Smart Device: Open the "Topeka First United Methodist" app. By scrolling up and down on your device, find the service you wish to listen to. Press the window of the sermon and listen to the <u>archived</u> version of the sermon. We sometimes select the Contemporary service and other times it will be from the Traditional service. As you can see, it contains all the sermons we have streamed.

On your PC: Open a browser and go to our website "forthegoodofthecity.org". Then click on the tab "**Sermons**", followed by clicking on "**Podcast**".

Scroll down to find the service you wish to hear, then press the Play button. This is the Archive version only.
